School and community service hours must be submitted during the semester they were earned to receive credit. Summer hours must be submitted during fall semester of the upcoming school year to receive credit.

Students should check the accumulation of their hours on a regular basis in their FOCUS account. Choose My Info/My Child Info, then click on Graduation.

Service Cord Eligibility is at 2 p.m. on the last Wednesday of March during a student's senior year. 150 or more hours must be completed, documented and submitted by that date to qualify for this honor.

What is the purpose of service hours?

- Recognition at graduation with a silver cord (150-249 hours) or gold cord (250+ hours) by senior year the end of March
- Florida Bright Futures: FAS (100 hours) and FMS (75 hours)
- Resume: for Scholarships, College Applications and Employment Applications
- National Honor Society (10th grade by end of semester 1 need 30 hours & qualifying GPA to receive application)

As a Lemon Bay High School student, you are encouraged to begin volunteering and documenting your volunteer hours early during your freshman year, in fact, please feel free to begin over the summer prior to starting 9th grade.
