FSA ELA

- Scores in the 10th grade count for graduation. ***Students must earn 350 or better on FSA ELA Reading/Writing in order to graduate and receive a standard diploma.***
- ***Students are allowed to take the test an additional four times during their 11th and 12th grades if needed.***
- ***Students may get an Reading ACT 19 or Reading-Writing SAT 430 / Reading SAT 24 concordant score their junior or senior year to fulfill FSA requirement.***



Florida Standards Assessments (FSA)

- FSA is based on the Sunshine State Standards that are established guidelines for expectations of students
- ELA Writing is in March 6th: 1 day test
- ELA Reading is in April 23rd – May 1st: 2 day test



End of Course Exams

- Students are required to pass the following End of Course (EOC) exam
 - Algebra I: May 2/3 - 2 day test
- Students will take EOC exams which count for 30% of the semester 1 and semester 2 grade for the following courses:
 - Geometry: May 2/3 - 2 day test
 - Biology: May 7/8 – 1 day test
 - US History: May 7/8 – 1 day test



Graduation Requirements

- 24 credits required for graduation
 - 4 credits in English (English 1, 2, 3, 4)
 - 4 credits in Math (1 credit must be Algebra 1 and 1 credit must be Geometry)
 - 3 credits in Science (1 credit must be Biology)
 - 1 credit World History
 - 1 credit American History
 - American Government .5 / Economics .5
 - 1 credit fine/performing art
 - 1 credit HOPE – taken @ LBHS earns Online credit
 - Online course through www.flvs.net

Example .5 credit Driver's Ed or
1 credit Photography

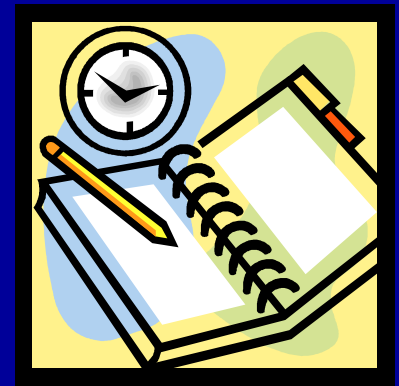
- 8 Electives





How do students earn credit?

- Students attend 7 periods per day
- You can earn .5 credit each semester per period
- You can earn 3.5 credits per semester
- You can earn 7 credits per year





What if a student fails a semester?



- Students may earn grade forgiveness if they earn a "C" or better for Q3 & Q4 and a "C" or better on their final exam. 9 or less days absent for that class in semester 2. Then the "F" can be changed to a "D". Must contact Mrs. Dailey.
- Students may attend Credit Retrieval after school one night per week to replace an "F" on their transcript with a "C" on completion of the course.
- Students may re-take the class on FLVS



Credit Retrieval - Edgenuity

- Students who fail to earn a credit during a semester may make that credit up by attending Credit Retrieval after school from 2:00-4:00 1 to 3 days a week T/W/TH
 - Academic courses only
 - Coursework and exams are on-line
 - The highest grade possible is a “C”



Grades

- Your semester grades are what determine your overall GPA. Semester grades are calculated as follows:
 - **1st Nine Weeks** **35%**
 - **2nd Nine Weeks** **35%**
 - **Semester Exam** **30%**
 - **Semester Grade** **100%**



High School Graduation Requirements

- 2.0 GPA (unweighted “C” average)
- 24 Credits
- Passing FSA Reading/Writing – 350
- Pass the FSA Algebra I EOC – 497 or
PERT Math Test – Comparative score 97
(not college ready)





What about G.P.A.'s?



- Grade point averages are calculated on each report card for that term
- GPA on the transcript is cumulative (including all grades earned so far)
- GPA is weighted and unweighted
- Weighted is for honors, A.P., and dual enrollment courses
- A= 4.0 B=3.0 C= 2.0 D=1.0 (unweighted)
- A= 4.5 B= 3.5 C= 2.5 D= 1.5 (Honors weighted)
- A= 5.0 B= 4.0 C = 3.0 D = 2.0 (AP/Dual credit weighted)

FSW/SCF

- Dual Credit Classes at FSW/SCF (online too)
 - GPA of at least 3.0 for Juniors/Seniors
 - Qualifying ACT, SAT, PERT Test Scores
 - LBHS & Parent Approval
- Early Admission
 - Part or All of 12th Grade



ACT/SAT/PERT

- PSAT in the 9th, 10th and 11th grade
- PSAT in the 10th grade (all students)
- ACT/SAT in grades 10 (only for college classes next year... doesn't count for college entrance), 11 and 12
- PERT in grades 9 – 12
- Honors/AP students need to take the ACT and/or SAT in the spring of 10th grade

Scholarships

- Grades
- SAT/ACT Scores
- Activities
- Community Service (75/100 hours BF)
 - State Scholarships (Bright Futures)
 - FMS 3.0 GPA can earn up to \$ per credit (4 year university)
 - FAS 3.5 GPA can earn up to \$ per credit (4year university)
 - Local Scholarships equal about \$600,000 or more a year
