Please note that any Advanced Placement (AP), Dual Enrollment (DE), Cambridge AICE, and Honors courses taken at Lemon Bay High School require a signed contract between the student, parent/guardian and school. Contracted Courses include:

AP Capstone Seminar, AP Capstone Research, Pre-AP English I(AICE General Paper), English 1 Honors (AICE General Paper), Pre-AP English II(AICE General Paper), English II Honors(AICE General Paper), AP Literature, AP Language, DE Composition(ENC 1101/1102), AP Studio Art, AP Human Geography, AP World History, AP American History, DE American History, AP American Government, Honors Biology, Honors Chemistry, AP Environmental Science, Honors Anatomy and Physiology, Honors Genetics, AP Biology, AP Chemistry, Honors Chemistry 2, Honors Physics, AICE Marine Science, AP Calculus, DE College Algebra, DE Statistics, DE Trigonometry, DE Pre-Calculus, & DE College Success Skills.

By initialing and signing below, I understand and acknowledge the rigorous nature of Advanced Placement/AICE/DE and Honors courses and state my intention to fully participate in college level/prep coursework.

_____ 1. Advanced Placement/AICE/DE and Honors courses are significantly more rigorous than general classes and are designed to simulate the pace and content of a college class.

_____ 2. Advanced Placement/AICE/DE and Honors courses require significant amount of study and reading time outside of the school day. One hour or more per night is not unusual to maintain adequate progress in the class.

_____ 3. Advanced Placement/AICE/DE and some Honors courses require summer assignments. These assignments are not optional and will be graded. Failure to complete these assignments will be considered grounds to remove a student from the course upon the start of the Fall semester.

_____ 4. Class sections are limited in Advanced Placement/AICE/DE and Honors courses. Not all students that apply will be registered. The final roster will be prepared by administration based on the following information: Overall GPA, grades in previous similar and prerequisite courses, attendance, and performance in previous AP classes and/or on previous AP tests. Furthermore, students participating in the associated courses will have preferential placement over students not participating.

_____ 5. Once enrolled in an Advanced Placement/AICE/DE and Honors courses, students will be expected to finish the year in that course and take the Advanced Placement/AICE/DE exam in the Spring. Schedule changes out of Advanced Placement/AICE/DE and Honors courses will not be honored once the Fall semester begins. Such schedule changes remain at the discretion of administration.

_____ 6. Students in Advanced Placement/AICE/DE classes are required to maintain a "C" semester average. Students failing to maintain a "C" semester average may be removed from the course at the end of the Fall semester and placed in an alternative course. Due to class size restrictions and the tight nature of the schedule, this may mean being scheduled into a general class or even an online version of the course as space permits.

_____ 7. Failure to take the Advanced Placement or AICE exam the conclusion of a course will result in the loss of AP/AICE weighting and will be replaced with honors weighting. In addition, failure to sit for an Advanced Placement or AICE exam will result in a financial obligation for the cost of the exam
