➤ Honors/AP

- Moving from a general class to an honors class requires:
 - At least a 3.0 GPA in the subject area (e.g. English),
 - Above average test scores on relevant standardized tests.
- Placement in Honors, AICE, DE and AP classes will be based on available space. In instances where more requests than seats exist for a given class, students will be registered for requested courses based on the following criteria: Previous grades in prerequisite and similar courses, previous successes on AP/AICE tests, overall GPA, test scores, and attendance.

➤ FSA Assessment and EOC'

- If you are not on level in an FSA/EOC subject area, you will be placed into an additional course to help with strategies.
- Math EOC scores (8th grade Math EOC, FSA Algebra 1 and FSA Geometry) will help determine course placement in Mathematics.

➤ Scheduling

- You must have all elective choices completed on the front in priority order. Make sure that you are willing to take any of the courses you listed as elective choices.
- There will be **NO schedule changes prior to the completion of Semester 1**. The only changes permitted will be if you do not have the prerequisite, or you are placed at the wrong level.
- If you have not earned an industry certification, you will be placed in a course to earn certification until you pass a certification assessment.

➤ Summer Assignments

- If you sign up for a course that has a summer assignment, assume that you are getting that course and complete the summer assignment prior to the start of school.
- All summer assignments are to be completed prior to the first day of school, failure to complete the summer assignment will have a drastic negative effect on your quarter 1 grade.
- Failure to complete summer assignments will not result in a schedule change.

➤ Online Course Requirement

- The following courses fulfill the Online requirement
 - Hope – with a passing grade
 - Industry Certification – Must pass the certification test, not the class.
