CALL TO ORDER - Larry Snyder, SAC Chair

Larry Snyder called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Larry Snyder made a motion to approve the meeting minutes from the April 18 and May 16, 2023 meeting, seconded by Dana Lutz and adopted by consensus.

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT - Bob Bedford

Hurricane Make-up Day - Mr. Bedford announced that due to the missed days during the recent storm, Charlotte County has designated a Hurricane Make-up Day for February 16, 2024, which was previously scheduled as a day off for students.

Student Government - Mrs. Cooper (SGA Sponsor) introduced Rose Lowder, SGA President and Shantal De Los Santos, SGA Vice President who reviewed activities for Homecoming week (October 9-13). A SignUp Genius link will be available on the school website for Homecoming Dance donations. SGA hosted the annual Club Day on Friday, September 1 where students were able to learn about getting involved with Clubs on campus.

Enrollment - Mr. Bedford noted that student enrollment is at 1,357 with 67 teachers and the plan to add one additional Math Coach to the staff.

Free Breakfast/Lunch - Students are once again provided with free breakfast and lunch this school year.

Testing - Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (F.A.S.T.) - Mr. Henry reviewed F.A.S.T. Progress Monitoring which was held in August for 9th and 10th graders. Retesting was also held for 11th and 12th graders who have not met the required achievement score. Progress Monitoring provides real-time

data to inform students, teachers and parents of student growth. Results will be available on FOCUS. The PSAT (Preliminary SAT) will be held in October for 10th graders which is the National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test.

School Improvement Plan (SIP) - Mr. Bedford presented the School Improvement Plan for the 2023-24 school year including strategies and resources that will be utilized to attain achievement goals for student gains. Mr. Bedford reviewed areas of focus including early warning system and school data with focus on achieving specific learning goals, instructional strategies, and teacher retention. The final SIP will be presented at the September 26 SAC Meeting for review and approval.

ACTIVITIES REPORT - Mr. Bedford

Volleyball, Cross Country, Swimming and Golf teams - Fall sports are currently in play.
