

A STUDENT GUIDE TO CREATING A LEMON BAY HIGH SCHOOL LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP PACKET

LEMON BAY HIGH SCHOOL LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP PACKETS INCLUDE:

- 1) Student **resume'** typed and shared with Mrs. Dailey for editing through Office 365 or Google - **September**
- 2) Student **goal statement** typed and shared with Mrs. Dailey for editing through Office 365 or Google - **October**
- 3) **Two staff letters** of recommendation – **November**
- 4) **One community letter** of recommendation – **November**
- 5) If you are planning on attending a Technical School – Only one letter of recommendation is required, but it would be beneficial to have all three.

LEMON BAY HIGH SCHOOL LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP PROCEDURE:

- ✓ Mrs. Dailey edits each resume' and goal statement, students will share these items. Then student will need to share the edited resume' (via Office365 or Google) with staff members who have agreed to write letters of recommendation on the student's behalf. The student hand-delivers or emails a resume' to the community person who has agreed to write a letter of recommendation.
- ✓ Mrs. Dailey prints a copy of each resume' and goal statement to include in the student's scholarship packet. Students sign their goal statements. Both documents are kept on file.
- ✓ Students will need to apply online at www.lemonbayhigh.com
 - Click on Academic & Guidance, scroll down to additional resources, the middle column under Local Scholarship Info: LBHS Local Scholarship Application 2022-2023. This becomes page 1 of the local scholarship packet and is added to the student's file.
 - This online application will be available after September 1st.
- ✓ Students collect their letters of recommendation and submit them to Mrs. Dailey. The letters are added to the student's file.
- ✓ From January-mid March, Mrs. Dailey distributes copies of completed scholarship packets to local committees that review packets and select scholarship recipients.
