High School Graduation Requirements

- 2.0 GPA (unweighted “C” average)
- 24 Credits
- Passing FSA Reading/Writing – 350 or Concordant score of 480 on SAT EBRW or ACT average of 18 on English & Reading
- Pass the FSA Algebra I EOC – 497 or obtain a Concordant score: PSAT/SAT Math: 430 or ACT Math: 16
 - School Day SAT- Spring 2022 (March)





Graduation Requirements

- 24 credits required for graduation
 - 4 credits in English (English 1, 2, 3, 4)
 - 4 credits in Math (1 credit must be Algebra 1 and 1 credit must be Geometry)
 - 3 credits in Science (1 credit must be Biology)
 - 1 credit World History
 - 1 credit American History
 - American Government .5 / Economics .5
 - 1 credit fine/performing art
 - 1 credit HOPE – taken @ LBHS earns Online credit
 - 8 Electives





A Junior Year Checklist for Students (and Parents)

- TAKE CARE OF YOUR GRADES!
 - Use FOCUS, Teachers, Tutoring
 - Work to fix "pot holes" in your grades.
 - Graduating with honors/retrieving credit
- Discuss Post LBHS Plans
 - College (2yr or 4yr), Technical College, Work force, Military
- Take SAT/ACT - fee waivers/college app waivers
- Plan for College Visits - in person (3 Activity days) or virtual
- Continue to build community service hours
- Continue to be involved on & off campus

Graduating with Honors Requirements

- **Summa Cum Laude**
 - 4.2 or higher weighted cumulative GPA and at least 12 weighted course credits with a “B” or higher (to include at least 4 Dual Credit, A.I.C.E., or Advanced Placement course credits).
 - A “D” or “F” as a final grade in any course at any time, including 8th semester, disqualifies students.
 - Grade forgiveness may not be applied to the GPA.
- **Magna Cum Laude**
 - 3.85 or higher weighted cumulative GPA, at least six weighted course credits with a “B” or higher
 - A “D” or “F” as a final grade in any course at any time, including 8th semester, disqualifies students.
 - Grade forgiveness in the same subject area may be applied.
- **Cum Laude**
 - 3.5 or higher weighted cumulative GPA
 - A “D” or “F” as a final grade in any course at any time, including 8th semester, disqualifies students.
 - Grade forgiveness in the same subject area may be applied.



- Dual Enrollment/ College Credit Courses
 - Online or In Person
 - 2 to 3 classes each semester
 - All costs covered by CCPS
 - Unweighted GPA of at least 3.0
 - Qualifying ACT, SAT, PERT Test Scores
 - LBHS & Parent Approval
- Early Admission (Senior year)
 - Student attends Full-Time
 - 4 or 5 classes, max 15 credit hours
 - Parent & Student will need to meet with their School Counselor and seek advisement from SCF academic advisor.
