I hereby apply for space at the Lemon Bay High School Manta Market. I understand I am renting the area within the marked outline of a parking space at Lemon Bay High School parking lot, located on 2201 Placida Road, Englewood, FL; 9:00 AM until 2:00 PM.

Hold Harmless Release Form

1. The vendor agrees to defend, indemnify and hold the Charlotte County School Board, its employees, agents or volunteers harmless from all demands, claims, causes of actions or judgments, for injury to person or property arising from omission, fault, negligence or other misconduct of the vendor, his/her partners, agents, employees or other representatives. In the event that the Manta Market, is made a party or threatened to be made a party to any litigation commenced by or against vendor, then vendor shall defend, indemnify and hold Charlotte County School Board, its employees, agents or volunteers harmless and shall pay all costs and expenses incurred in investigating or resisting the same, including reasonable attorney's fees, that may be incurred or paid by the Manta Market in connection with such threatened or actual litigation.

2. In no event will the Charlotte County School Board, its employees, agents or volunteers be liable or held accountable to vendors for any loss, interruption of business, or any direct, indirect, special, incidental or consequential damage of any kind, harm or injury to the person or property of vendor resulting from theft, fire, water, accident or any other cause, regardless of the form of action whether in contract, tort (including negligence) or otherwise.

3. By submitting an application to participate in the Manta Market, vendor represents and warrants that the vendor has read this Agreement and understands and agrees to all applicable rules and policies for participation in any of the Manta Markets from November 2019 through March 2020. Vendors understand that noncompliance with any rule or policy may result in exclusion from participation in the current Manta Market and in future Markets.

Manta Market Rules and Policies

1. Vehicles are to be parked in the assigned vendor parking spaces only. Parking in customer parking, is taking away from potential customers.
2. Vendors must be set up by 8:45 and shall not break down until 2:00pm. No vehicles in vending area between 8:45-2:15 for the safety of vendors and customers.
3. Vendors cannot sublet their space to others. Double space is for one vendor only and only if available.
4. All trash caused or created by vendor is to be removed by vendor.
5. No products containing CBD oils, market is considered a school fundraiser, product sends conflicting message
6. Fine Arts and Craft items need to be handmade and will be juried. No retail, No Direct Sales. We reserve a very limited number of spaces for "And More" that do not compete with our handmade artisans.
7. Vendors are responsible for collecting and reporting sales tax, if it is required.
8. Vendors are to provide their own tables. Sorry no electric is available or will be provided.
9. Prepared food items that are to be sold by vendors must have proper county permits.
10. All tents are required to have tent weights for the safety of vendors and customers. Any harm or damage caused by a dislodged tent is the vendor's responsibility. 40lbs per leg minimum.
11. No refunds for no shows or cancellations. Paid vendor fees are non-transferable. Please make sure you can make the dates you sign up for.
12. All Market dates are rain or shine. Severe weather could result in canceling or postponing.

Market Time: 9a.m.-2 p.m.

- ❖ Vendors can arrive at 7:00 a.m. - 8:45 a.m. to check in and set up. The vendors map will be emailed to you the Wednesday PM before the market and also handed out at vendor check in. If you do not receive an email after checking your spam, please email Manta Market.
- ❖ Spaces are marked with a numbered cone and an orange dot the left and to the right of it. This marks the width of your space. A space is a 10 wide x15 deep.
- ❖ **Set up. Drive up to your space, unload, remove your vehicle to designated vendor parking, and then return to set up. Do not leave your unloaded vehicle in the vending area. For the safety of patrons and other vendors, vehicles will not be permitted to return to the vending area until 2:15pm. Again, pack up, take down your tent, then get your vehicle to load.**
